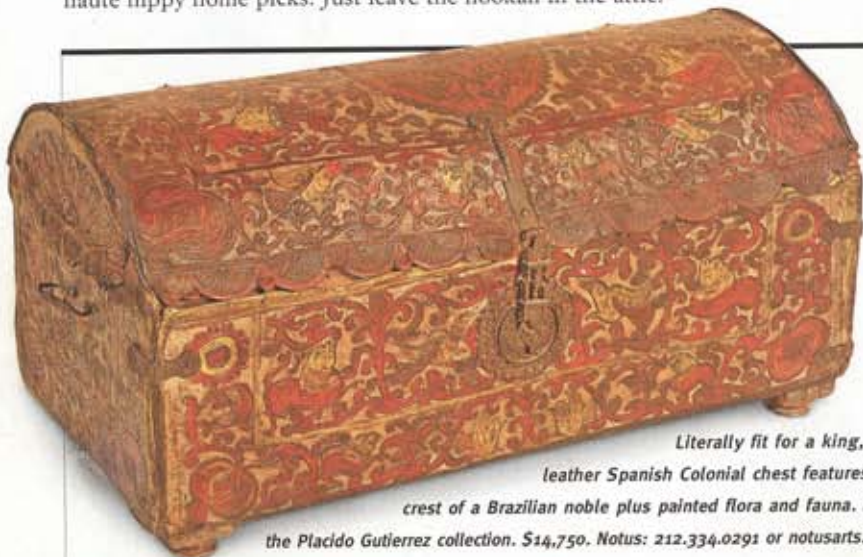


MIND YOUR DESIGN
